Articles will be judged on color, design, appropriateness, workmanship, and cleanliness. (Soiled articles will be disqualified by the judge.)

*Hints on what Judges look for:*

1. Be sure articles are completely finished off, i.e. rug binding completed; seams completed; yarn ends woven in.
2. Be sure articles are in the correct category, i.e. Wall hangings must have hangers; Hot mats and pot holders must be usable as same.
