Entry Fees:

Pre-entry registration is \$5.00 per horse per day.
Post-entry registration is \$10.00 per horse per day.

Post entry fees will be charges for all entries received after August 1, 2010.

STALL SPACE IS LIMITED AND WILL BE GIVEN ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS ; BASED ON ENTRY POSTMARKS

All exhibitors with paid entries received before August 1st will receive two (2) passes per horse entered, with a maximum of six (6) passes, upon entrance to the Fair Grounds with their animals. All post entry exhibitors will have to pay admission to the fairgrounds with no reimbursements given. All exhibitors must enter through the Green Gate on Stockwell Road.

No refund of entry fees except in the case of bona fide injury to animal or exhibitor, or irreparable damage to equipment.

All Exhibitors must send in with their entries a Certificate of Insurance of \$300,000 and must be in the hands of the secretary BEFORE premiums are paid.

Ambulance, Food, and Water are available on grounds.

Sawdust Bedding is available on the grounds. Hay may be purchased from Matt & Barbara Smith on the grounds by calling 802/328-3879 in advance.

Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes as entries warrant.

Premium money will be mailed within two weeks after the show.

NOTICE

By New Hampshire State Law, all out of state horses, except nursing foals, must have a Negative Coggins Test that is less than six months old. ALL HORSES ENTERING THE FAIRGROUNDS MUST HAVE A CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION.

DIVISION AND PREMIUMS

HALTER DIVISION

To be judged 60% on conformation and breed type; 40% on way-of-going, disposition and manners. Weanling and Yearling classes to be judged 70% on conformation and breed type; and 30% on way-of-going, disposition and manners. Six ribbons will be offered in all classes except Championships. Classes may be divided by age, breed, or sex as entries warrant.

TEAMSTER AWARD

Teamster must demonstrate proficiency in handling single horses and multiple hitches. To qualify a Teamster must enter at least one halter class and drive in the single, pair, unicorn, four, and six horse hitch classes. The Teamsters will be asked to perform certain maneuvers by the judge following the six horse hitch. The choice of maneuvers will be up to the judge and each Teamster may not be asked to perform the same things.

*****NOTICE*****

All Exhibitors housing their Horses/Ponies in the Draft Horse Barn or Pony Tent will provide a barrier behind their animals which must be maintained while the animal is in this area.

All Exhibitors must send in with their entries a Certificate of Insurance of \$300,000 and must be in the hands of the secretary BEFORE premiums are paid.

The Draft Horse Barn will be closed to spectators from Noon until one hour after the last class on each day to give the exhibitors space to work with their horses. Each exhibit will have a representative available while the barn is open to the public.
