For the Adult entry—2 Layer frosted cake—whatever recipe He/She desires

5. An entry form must accompany the entry. (entry form available online or at Shaw's of Lancaster)

6. All entries must be submitted on a disposable container for judging. (Juniors 12 2 1/2" --3" cookies)(Adults entire cake)

7. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

Flavor	50 Points
Overall Appearance	25 Points
Texture	<u>25 Points</u>
TOTAL	100 Points
