



ATV Sled Pull Classes & Rules

ATV Classes:

200 to 500cc 4 Wheel Drive 1150lb Max Weight
501 to 600cc 4 Wheel Drive 1200lb Max Weight
601 to 800cc 4 Wheel Drive 1300lb Max Weight
801 to 990cc 4 Wheel drive 1350lb Max Weight
1000 cc 4 Wheel drive Mex Weight?

Side By Side Classes:

0 to 600cc 1300lb Max Weight
601 to 990cc 1400lb Max weight
991+ cc 1450lb Max Weight
900 - 4 Seat - No Max Weight
1000 – 4 Seat No Max Weight
Turbo Class – No Max Weight

General Information:

1. Sign up begins at one hour before first pull (5:00 PM)
2. ATVS WILL NOT be allowed to roam the Fairgrounds. All ATVs will be parked next to gate 2 in a designated area.
3. Only entrants 16 YEARS OF AGE and older are able to participate. All operators under the age of 18 must have written consent of parent or guardian, and parent or guardian must be present for driver to pull,
4. All entrants must sign a Release and Waiver of Liability Form
5. All Drivers must wear a shirt, pants, shoes and a helmet
6. All Machines must be in Safe Mechanical Condition.
7. Entry Fees: **\$20.00 per hook**
8. Must be a minimum of 3 entrants to run any class. Classes may be combined.
9. No refunds of registration fees if disqualified or scratched. Exception is if a class is dropped due to sled malfunction or lack of entrants.
10. There may be tech inspections.
11. Keep it FUN.

Rules:

1. Sign up starts one hour before pull begins. All entries are stopped once the first ATV of that class hooks to the sled.
2. Contest is open to 4 Wheel ATVs; or 4 wheel drive. 3-Wheel ATV's will not be allowed to participate.
3. No blocked suspension allowed.
4. All drivers must supply their own clevis/Eye to hook chain. No pulling on hitch balls. Minimum hole size 1.75".
5. Machines must have a hitch no higher than 16.5 inches to the clevis or ring.
6. Each weight class will include the weight of the machine plus the weight of the driver.
7. ALL ATV's must be operated in a safe manner on and off the track. No speeding or wheelies allowed.

8. No chains, studs, or duals allowed.
9. ATV must have working brakes, fenders over the 2 rear tires, and a spring return throttle
10. The first puller in each class is the "Test Puller". He/she has the option to re-pull immediately; however, he/she will be giving up their first pull in doing so. Decision to re-pull must be made before ATV is unhooked from the sled.
11. If any part of the ATV goes out of bounds during the pull, you are disqualified.
12. The puller can re-hook 1 time if attempt is made to shut down before the Oft mark.
13. All pulls will start with a tight hitch. No jerking, swerving or bouncing is allowed.
14. All weights to be fastened securely to the machine. The loss of any object while hooked to the sled will be a disqualification. (NO TARP STRAPS or BUNGEE CORDS ALLOWED)
15. All ties must be pulled off to determine placing.
16. Only gas or diesel is permitted for use as a fuel. Neither nitrous oxide nor pressurized fuels are allowed.
17. At their discretion, any contestant may opt to advance to a higher weight or CC class.
18. Only one driver per machine per class. (May allow multiple drivers if time permits, only first driver will receive trophy, ribbons or prize money)
19. Driver must remain seated on seat during the pull. No portion of body may extend forward of the handle bars.
20. All entrants must abide by the rules. The officials will settle any discrepancies in the rules and their decisions are FINAL and must be accepted in a sportsman-like manner.
21. Each participant is responsible for lost or stolen articles, injury or property damage.
22. Changes presented the day of the event will take precedence over printed material.
23. Continuing to attempt to pull after red light, disqualification will result.
24. Alcohol or glass containers will not be permitted in the pit area. Violators including drivers and pit crews will be disqualified and asked to leave.
