

# Lancaster Fair Camping Rules and Regulations

## Reservations:

- Reservations will not be accepted without a completed reservation form along with full payment. Please make checks payable to: **Lancaster Fair Camping**. Visa and Mastercard are also accepted.
- As we have done in the past, we will hold your campsite from the prior year until July 1<sup>st</sup>. After that date, sites **not paid for in full** may be issued to people currently on the waiting list.
- **Please remember** that our sites vary in depth and width. If the size indicated in the pricing chart is not adequate to accommodate your camper or RV, you may wish to move or rent additional space, but you must make arrangements to do so prior to your stay.
- We must now limit spaces in Lines C, D, and HP to agricultural exhibitors and horse pullers only. A preferred rate package is offered to exhibitors only. All other campers and concessionaires will be charged per night starting the Tuesday before the fair, if their campers are parked and using the utilities.
- Exhibitors receiving the preferred rate package must list the directors name with whom they work at the bottom of the reservation form.

## Camping Area Conduct:

- Quiet hours are from 11:00PM to 7:00AM. No generators are to be used during this time except for approved medical necessities.
- It is illegal in the State of New Hampshire to dump gray/black water onto or into the ground.
- **Only one car** is allowed per site. Please be considerate of others' space. Stickers or hang-tags will be provided at check-in.
- **Check-out time is 11:00AM** except on Labor Day. Please feel free to park your camper/rv in the large parking lot so that you may enjoy the rest of the day with us.
- **Dogs must be on a leash at all times** and are not allowed on the mid-way. Dogs that bark persistently or exhibit aggressive behavior will be expelled from the fairgrounds. The fair directors reserve the right to expel any animal. Owner assumes all risk and liability should injury occur. Dog waste must be disposed of properly and immediately. Dogs are not to be left outside without the owner present.

- **Secure all valuables.** The Lancaster Fair is not responsible for property loss, theft or damage.
- We rely on you to keep our camping area clean. Campfires are allowed in raised fire-pits only. Please extinguish all fires when leaving site.
- All campers must use their assigned campsite and may not move sites without prior approval from the director in charge of camping.
- Alcohol may only be consumed by those 21 years of age or older in designated camping areas. Alcohol may not be carried from campsites onto fairgrounds including mid-way, buildings, or entertainment areas.
- Campground rule offenders asked to leave the grounds will not receive a refund.
- These campground rules are for your protection. Completion of the Campground Request Form and payment thereof constitutes acceptance of the foregoing rules by the adult in charge and all persons using the assigned area.
